 1. **[Agenda Item 2026-01-10-009 Agenda](#)**; Area 41 submit a proposed agenda item for the 77th General Service Conference to consider changing the policy for how the conference agenda is set to give conference committees the ability to have a formal role in setting their agenda, instead of the General Service Board having exclusive authority to set the General Service Conference agenda.
 2. **[Agenda Item 2026-01-10-001 Finance](#)**: Amend Area 41's Financial Guidelines to update the dollar amounts set for what expenses can be approved by the treasurer from \$100 to \$150 and the Finance Committee from \$400 to \$500 as outlined in Section 4, paragraph 1, sections a,b, and c.
 3. **[Agenda Item 2026-01-10-003 Finance](#)**: To remove any “Sponsorships or Incentive” payments from outside venues when considering hotel bids. Area 41 will not accept such offers.
 4. **[Agenda Item 2026-01-10-010 Agenda](#)**: Area 41 submit a proposed agenda item for the 77th General Service Conference to consider requiring candidates for new Non-Trustee Director and General Service Trustee positions to have been rotated out for at least one year from previous Conference or Board-level service.
